Cutting Instructions



Fabric Requirements

- A. 12.5" square of background fabric
- B. 9" x 6" "fabric
- C. 9" x 6" "fabric
- D. 6" square" fabric
- E. 6" square fabric

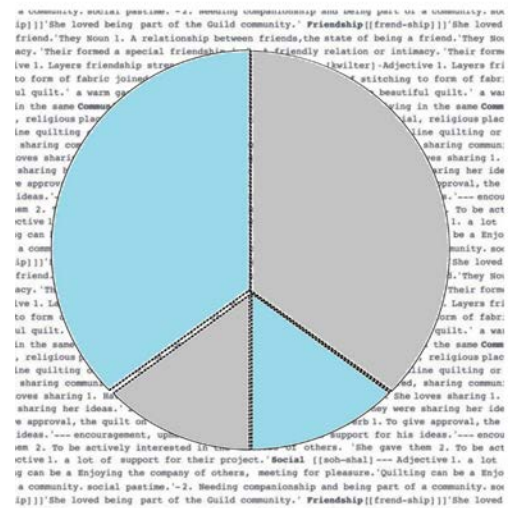
Applique

Prepare templates B,C,D,E for raw-edge fusible appliqué:

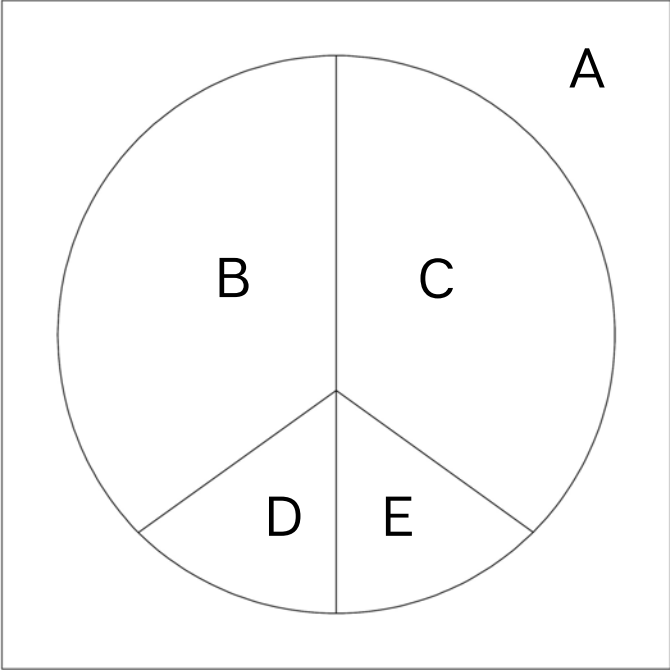
- Place the template on top of the fusible web, with the paper side facing up. Trace the template onto the paper side of the fusible web.
- Roughly cut out the shape, leaving a .25" allowance around the edge.
- Place the fusible web, onto the wrong side of the appliqué fabric with the fusible side down. Use your iron and follow the manufacturer's instructions to fuse the web to the fabric. Let cool.
- Cut along the pencil markings on the paper backing. Remove the paper backing just before you are ready to fuse the appliqué to the background fabric.
- Arrange web fused fabrics B, C, D, and E onto the right side of A (12.5" square of background fabric).
- Press sections of the peace sign.

Sew around each section with your choice of stitch:

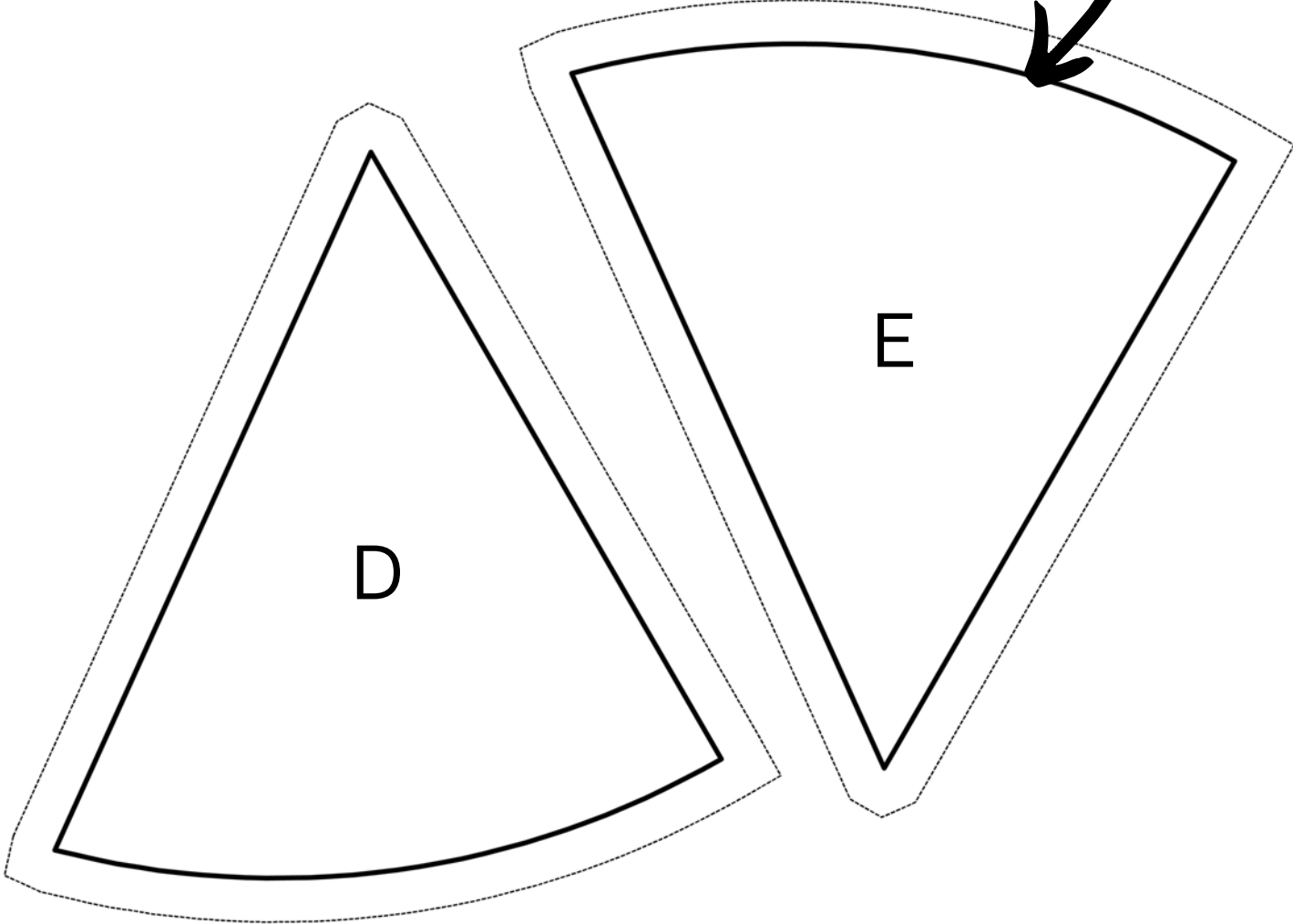
- blanket stitch
- blind hem
- straight stitch
- invisible stitch
- zigzag stitch
- satin stitch

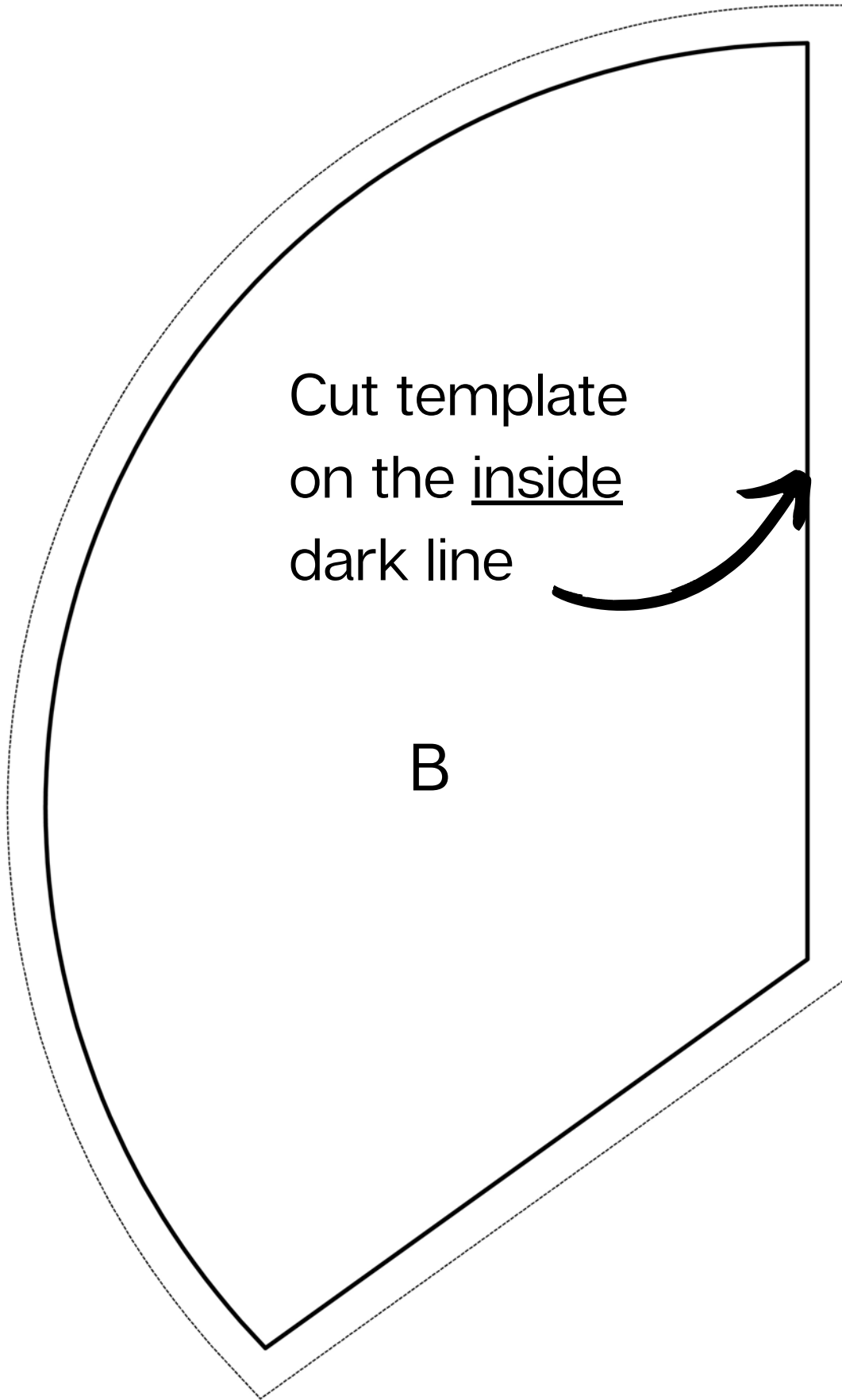


Peace Sign



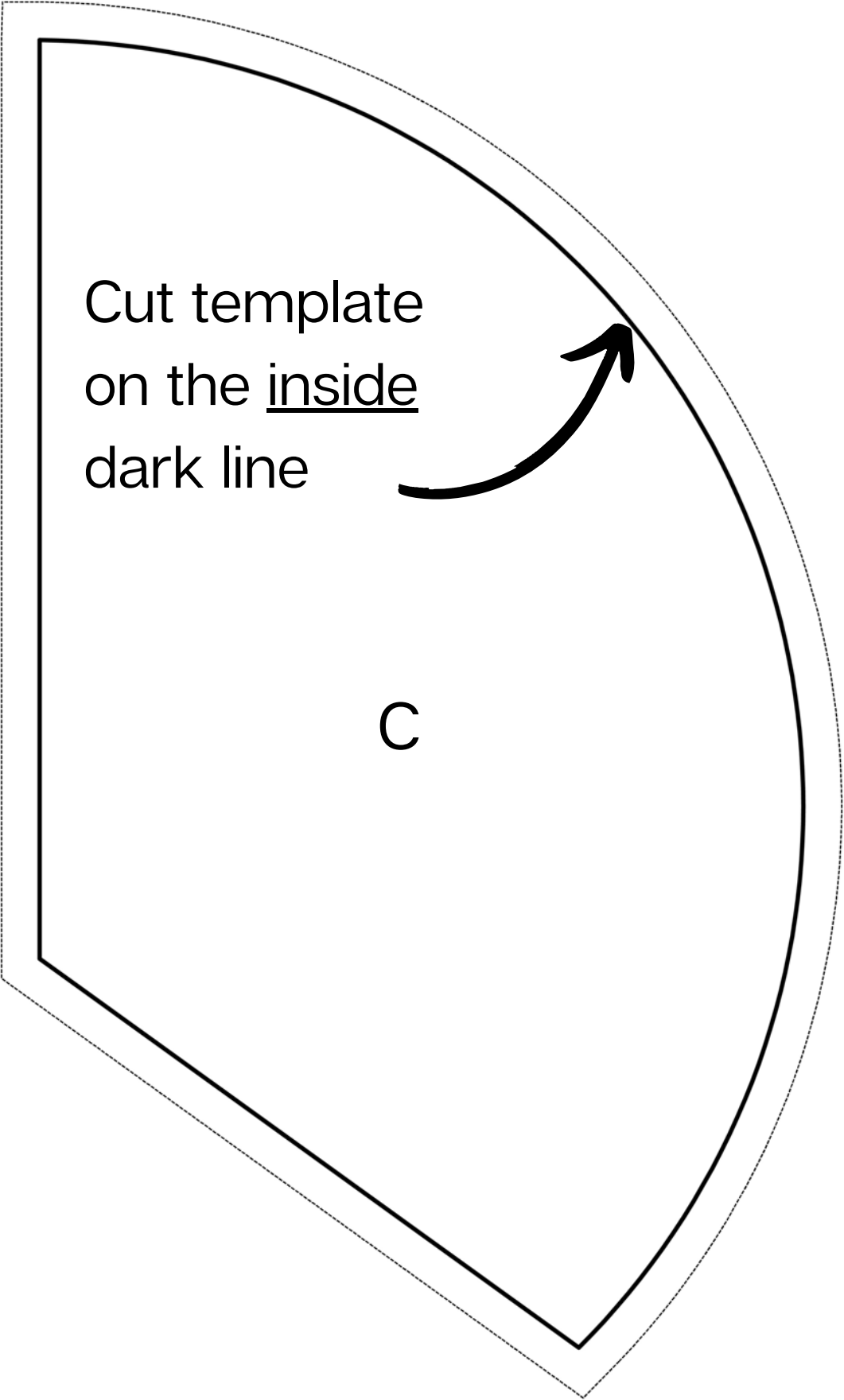
Cut templates on the inside darker line
